

Thank you for the contribution that you have made to the club over the busy holiday period.






- VALE - COLIN MACLEAN

Long time member Colin Maclean sadly passed away last week after a long illness at the age of 81. A member for 67 years, Colin joined the club as a cadet in the 1958/59 season and gained his qualifying certificate. He subsequently obtained his Bronze Medallion in the 59/60 season and Instructor's Certificate in 1962.

A highly competitive board rider, Colin won the Branch long board championship 6 times, including 5 consecutive titles between 1962 and 1966. He also a branch medallist in surf ski and board relay events. His last competitive success was in 1999 when he won a Branch Master's silver medal in the 150yrs Taplin Relay. He was also club champion in board events on a number of occasions.

Beyond competition Colin was also actively involved in club administration. He undertook a range of duties during his time including General Committee member, board captain, Gear Steward and Social Organiser.

In honour of Duke's inspirational surfing display held at Freshwater Beach during the summer of 1914-15 that popularised surfing in Australia and ignited the northern beaches surf industry.

With a quiet return last year the event was warmly welcomed back and now once again a fixture in the January calendar!

- Thursday 9th is the Opening Aloha night at Freshwater Brewery sponsored by Hawaiian Tourism, with live music and hula dancers to reignite our Aloha spirit
- Friday 10th features the Official Lei Draping Ceremony at the statue

- Have you seen Waterman the Movie? An award-winning documentary about Duke Kahanmoku's trailblazing lifetime achievements. Come along to the films and enjoy a wind-down drink afterwards.

FSLSC members have been central to this celebration from its inception, and we look forward to seeing many 'old' and new members join in the festivities next weekend. 
